- 1. Complete and mail the attached West Virginia Partners in Technology scholarship application and contract.
- 2. Apply for admission to Hocking College for one of the following programs:  
Accounting and Financial Services, American Art, Design and Marketing, Archaeology, Baking and Culinary Arts, Biotechnology, Broadcast Production and Engineering, Business Management and Entrepreneurship, Computer Electronics, Computer Programming, Construction Management, Culinary Arts, E Commerce and Web Design, Ecotourism and Adventure Travel, Educational Paraprofessional, Farrier Science and Business, Fire and Emergency Services, Fish Management and Aquaculture, Fish Management and Aquaculture Science, Fitness Management, Forest Management, Hotel and Restaurant Management, Human Services and Corrections, Interactive Multimedia, International Business, International Hospitality, Medical Assistant, Medical Records/Health Information Management, Natural and Historical Interpretation, Network Systems, Nutrition and Dietetics, Office Management, Opticianry, Police Science, Ranger Services, Recreation and Wildlife, Spa Management, Timber Harvesting and Tree Care Certificate, Wildlife Management, and Wildlife Science.
- 3. Apply for Federal financial aid programs using the FAFSA and complete all financial aid requirements.
- 4. Register and attend according to enrollment guidelines.

## Initial Program Eligibility Requirements

The student must meet the following eligibility requirements before a West Virginia Partners in Technology monetary award can be made. Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in ineligibility for the West Virginia Partners in Technology scholarship program.

1. Be a 2007 graduate from a West Virginia high school.
  2. Complete and submit the attached West Virginia Partners in Technology Scholarship Application and Contract.
  3. Apply for admission to Hocking College and pursue a degree in one of the eligible programs. (For a complete list of eligible programs, see #2 on Page 1.)  
OR  
Complete a formal change of technology form changing from a non-eligible technology to an eligible technology.
  4. If attending summer, enroll in any number of credit hours; **if attending fall, winter or spring, enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours in your program.** Students must be registered by the 15th day of the quarter in order to receive an award for that quarter. Flex courses do not count as part of a student's eligible credit hours.
  5. Apply for the Federal Pell Grant using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA on the web: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)) and complete all financial aid requirements.

## Determination of Monetary Award Amounts

For students enrolled full time (12 or more credit hours), the West Virginia Partners in Technology scholarship will cover \$1000 of the out-of-state tuition surcharge (listed on billing statements as out of state). For part time students (summer quarter only), the award amount will be adjusted according to the number of credit hours registered.

All other charges (regular and the balance of out-of-state tuition and fees, course fees, books and supplies, etc.) are not covered by the West Virginia Partners in Technology scholarship program and are the responsibility of the student. The student is responsible for any interest and penalty charges incurred if payment is not made.

Awards will be applied to the student's account each quarter after verifying that eligibility requirements have been met (see quarterly eligibility requirements below). Any West Virginia Partners in Technology scholarship award amounts listed on your Financial Aid Notification are pending quarterly review of eligibility.

The West Virginia Partners in Technology application must be submitted no later than the 15th day of the quarter. Awards will not be retroactive. Applications received after the 15th day of the quarter will be processed for the next quarter of enrollment. In order to register for classes, a student must have a finalized West Virginia Partners in Technology award or make payment. Students who have not finalized their West Virginia Partners in Technology award prior to the first day of the quarter will be required to pay their tuition in full.
