Social Work Program

The Social Work program is designed to prepare students to enter the workforce in the mental health and addiction/prevention workforce. The program provides students with relevant curriculum along with hands on field experiences. The students will learn about ethical and professional standards to follow when engaging in working with numerous populations such as but not limited to, aging adults, adults, teens, children, and the family system.

Through our “hands on approach” the students will engage in various field experiences. This allows the student to determine which area of focus in social work they would like to pursue further. Students will participate in community outreach and social justice to assist in supporting the campus and local communities.

Our Social Work program, just as today’s field of Social Work, offers employment opportunities in person and virtually. For this reason, our Social Work program uses a hybrid model. Our hybrid model ensures that our students are well prepared and able to demonstrate competence in the areas of study upon graduation.

Our Associate of Arts in Social Work acts as a pathway, leading directly into a Bachelor’s Degree in Social Work or Counseling. This approved pathway allows students to count their completed courses at Hocking College towards their bachelor’s degree in the social work or counseling field.
