Automotive Technology Degree Program

Students of the Automotive Technology degree program at Hocking College gain hands-on experience through coursework, live learning labs, and industry participation. Students learn the fundamentals of automotive technology as well as management skills for the industry.

The following are skills, behaviors, and attitudes cultivated in students seeking the Associate Degree in Automotive Technology:

- Operate tools equipment and resources related to Automotive Service in a safe and prescribed manner.
- Research, communicate diagnosis/estimate, document, and bill for completed service procedures utilizing appropriate technology.
- Evaluate customer concerns and diagnose possible system or component malfunctions.
- Inspect, Diagnose, Repair/Replace and/or Rebuild automotive suspension, brake, drivetrain, HVAC, emission, power-plant, and engine control systems.
- Determine the correct procedure for the repair and then correctly perform the procedure.
- Apply good customer relations skills in all interactions with customers.
