

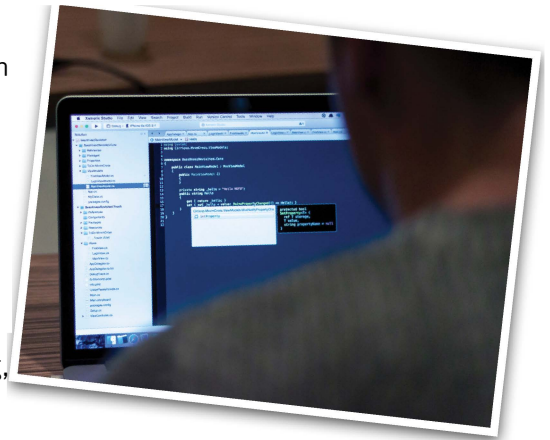


Cyber Security & Network Systems

Cybersecurity & Network Systems Program

The Cybersecurity and Network Systems program combines a strong foundation in networking with hands-on cybersecurity education to prepare resilient and adaptable cybersecurity professionals for evolving digital world. Through immersive labs, real-world projects, and a curriculum that intentionally integrates artificial Intelligence alongside emerging technologies, students develop the technical expertise, professional judgment, ethical decision-making, and problem solving skills needed to secure, manage and defend modern technology environments. Graduates are prepared for industry certifications, transfer opportunities, and careers across cybersecurity, networking, cloud, and IT operations.



PROGRAM PARTNERSHIPS

To provide students with industry-relevant education and experiences, the Cybersecurity and Network Systems program partners with leading technology and cybersecurity organizations, including Cisco Networking Academy, AWS Academy, EC-Council, and Comp TIA. These partnerships enhance the curriculum with industry-recognized learning resources, hands-on training, certification preparation, and emerging technologies that prepare graduates for continued education and success in an evolving cybersecurity profession.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

Students enrolled in the Cybersecurity & Network Systems Program can continue their education through Hocking College's 3+1 partnership with Franklin University. Through the Franklin University Pathway Portal, graduates can maximize transfer credits and complete an Online Bachelors of Science in Cybersecurity while benefiting from a reduced pathway Portal tuition rates, providing an affordable and seamless pathway to earn a bachelor's degree.
