PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Dental Hygiene Degree Program

Students who successfully complete two academic years of full-time instruction in the Dental Hygiene Program are awarded an Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene. Graduates of the program are eligible to sit for the National Dental Hygiene Board Examination, the ADEX CDCA Dental Hygiene Examination, the ADEX CDCA Local Anesthesia Examination, and the Ohio State Dental Board (OSDB) Jurisprudence Examination. Upon graduation and successful completion of all required board examinations, graduates are eligible for licensure in the State of Ohio and participating portable states.

The curriculum includes coursework in four primary areas: General Education, Biomedical Sciences, Dental Sciences, and Dental Hygiene Sciences. The courses provide a comprehensive foundation in oral structural development, as well as the prevention, progression, and treatment of oral disease. The program emphasizes professional and ethical interactions with patients and other health care professionals. In addition, students develop effective communication skills through patient interactions and instructional methods incorporated throughout the curriculum.

EMPLOYMENT

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average annual salary for dental hygienists is approximately \$81,400. Nationally, salaries typically range from \$61,500 to \$107,640, depending on geographic location and practice setting. Dental hygienists are employed in a variety of professional environments, including private dental practices, community clinics, dental and pharmaceutical sales, public health, and academic institutions.


