EMT/Paramedic Certificate Program

Hocking College's EMS/Paramedic Program provides top quality education to students who desire to be emergency medical technicians and paramedics. The College's approach to providing the knowledge and skills necessary to perform the tasks as an EMT and paramedic is to focus on hands-on learning in an environment that simulates the real world in which they will encounter.

After successfully completing the one semester basic EMT course, you're qualified to take the National Registry of EMTs exam that is required to gain State of Ohio Certification. Passage of the National Registry exam involves both a psychomotor assessment of skills and a written exam. Likewise, completion of the three-semester paramedic program also allows for candidates to take the psychomotor and written testing from the National Registry and gain State of Ohio certification.



ACCREDITATION

The Paramedic Program is accredited through the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Professions (CoAEMSP) and the EMT program is accredited through the Ohio Department of Public Safety – Division of EMS.
