



# Healthcare Informatics


## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Healthcare Informatics program prepares students for an exciting career as a Certified Associate in Health Information Management Systems (CAHIMS) in just two years. This flexible program is available hybrid or all online, allowing students to complete coursework in a format that best fits their schedule and learning style.

A Health Information Technician is skilled in health information management systems and procedures, has completed an accredited academic program, and has successfully passed an international certification exam through HIMSS's CAHIMS examination. Health Information Technicians use computer applications to assemble, analyze, and abstract medical records and often specialize in coding diagnoses and procedures for reimbursement and research.

They may also perform data retrieval for quality assurance activities, protect confidential patient information, and assist physicians and other healthcare professionals with accurate medical record documentation practices.

Additionally, students enrolled in Health Information Management courses will be eligible to sit for the CBCS, CEHRS, and CAHIMS certifications. These certifications are accredited by the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) and the Health Information Management Systems Society (HIMSS).
