This program provides students with campus projects and employment opportunities in order to become proficient in operating machines such as a bulldozer, tracked excavator, backhoe, road grader, skid steer, vibratory compactor, wheel loader, and off-road dump truck.

Our students work directly with Local 18 Heavy Equipment Operating Engineers during their course of study, many of whom secure apprenticeships and jobs through Local 18 once they complete the program. Additionally, we have relationships with many other regional employers who are looking for those who possess the skills learned at Hocking College.
