



# LPN to RN Transition Program

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

### Nursing Transition Program

The LPN to RN track includes one transition course, followed by a three-semester course of study that allows a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) to complete the requirements for an associate degree and become eligible to take the **NCLEX-RN**.

The nursing program is rich in hands-on experience. Clinical experience for the nursing program is obtained in hospitals and long-term care facilities within a 75-mile to 100-mile radius of the college. Applicants should meet with an assigned advisor to determine an individualized academic plan.

After successful completion of the LPN to RN Transition semester, the student is admitted into the final three clinical semesters of the Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing. Upon passing the national exam, the graduate will be licensed as a Registered Nurse.

The LPN must apply for admission to Hocking College, provide verification of an active, unrestricted license as an LPN and successfully complete the TEAS test. Students are responsible for their own transportation to clinical sites.



## ACCREDITATION



The Registered Nursing Program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) and is approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing (OBN).
