

Medical Assistant

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- * Medical Assistants work alongside physicians, mainly in outpatient or ambulatory care facilities, such as medical offices and clinics. Medical assistants are cross-trained to perform administrative and clinical duties, making them capable of working in any area of the office.
- * Students will have hands-on labs where they will practice skills under the supervision of instructors. Some of the medical assisting duties include, but not limited to: Taking medical histories, Assisting with minor office surgery, Collecting and preparing laboratory specimens, Preparing and administering medications, Phlebotomy, Performing electrocardiograms, Wound care and dressing changes, Inputting patient data using an electronic system, Coding and billing health insurance, and Scheduling appointments.
- * In year two, students will have two practicum experiences where they go to an area physician's office and perform those skills in a real-world environment. After graduation, students are eligible to sit for the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA) exam. In demand, Medical Assisting is one of the nation's careers growing much faster than average for all occupations.

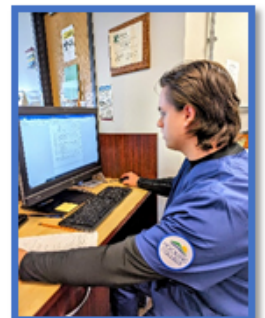
