PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Registered Nursing Program

Hocking College's Registered Nursing (RN) program offers a four-semester clinical/theory training which prepares students to take the National Council of Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). Enriched clinical experiences for the nursing program are obtained in hospitals, long-term care facilities, and clinics within a 75-mile to 100-mile radius of the college. Students participate in simulation exercises within the human patient simulation lab and the nursing skills lab, and are given numerous hours in the clinical setting to learn and practice skills.



PROGRAM PRE-REQUISITES

Students must complete pre-clinical curriculum prior to beginning clinical placement. As part of the orientation process, students are required to complete pre-clinical requirements, such as a background check, drug screen, vaccination records, physical examination and CPR for the professional rescuer. In addition, students need to pass the TEAS exam at the "proficient level" to be considered for the program.

ACCREDITATION



The Registered Nursing Program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) and is approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing (OBN).
