#### Final Exam Prep Strategies

- Use active recall: Quiz yourself on key terms and concepts rather than just rereading notes.
- Teach it: Try explaining topics to a friend (or even your pet!)—if you can teach it, you know it!

#### Time Management Tools

- Set a timer: Try the Pomodoro Technique—25 minutes of focused work, followed by a 5-minute break.

#### **Study Tips**


- Find your space: Choose a study environment that minimizes distractions (the TRIO Lab is a great option!).
